<u>Ticket Information Utilization Bylaw No. 77, 1992</u>

Bylaw 936

WHEREAS the *Community Charter* authorizes the Council of the District of Sicamous, by bylaw, to:

- designate those bylaws which may be enforced by means of a form of ticket prescribed by regulation;
- (2) designate bylaw enforcement officers for the purpose of enforcing bylaws by means of a prescribed form of ticket;
- (3) authorize the use of any word or expression on a ticket to designate an offence against a bylaw;
- (4) set fines no greater than the amount prescribed by regulation;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the District of Sicamous, in open meeting assemble, **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**




1. The bylaws listed in Column 1 of Schedule 1 of this bylaw may be enforced by means of a ticket in the form prescribed in the *Community Charter*.



2. Persons appointed to a position listed in Column 2 of Schedule 1 of this bylaw are designated as Bylaw Enforcement Officers, pursuant to the *Community Charter*, for the purpose of enforcing the bylaws listed in Column 1 opposite those positions.



3. The words or expressions set forth in Column 1 of Schedules 2 -14 of this Bylaw designate the offence committed under the Bylaw section number appearing in Column 2 opposite the respective words or expressions.



- 4. The amounts appearing in Column 3 of Schedules 2 -14 of this Bylaw are the fines set pursuant to the *Community Charter* for the corresponding offences designated in Column 1.
- 5. This Bylaw may be cited as the "District of Sicamous Ticket Information Utilization Bylaw No. 77, 1992."
