

## COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS | APRIL 13, 2022



- Council proclaimed 2022 as the Year of the Garden in support of Sicamous Communities in Bloom.
- Council approved <u>Development Variance Permit 21-233-DVP</u> for 1201 Shuswap Ave to vary the side setback from 2m to 1.27m and the rear setbacks from 6m to 0m for the existing building and addition with dwelling unit.
- Council approved <u>Development Permit 21-343-DP</u> and <u>Development Variance Permit 21-343-DVP</u> for upgrades to an exiting marina at 1202 Young Crescent to vary the minimum lot line setback and maximum lot area, in support of the foreshore lease renewal.
- Council approved <u>Development Variance Permit Application 21–044–DVP</u> for 711 Parksville Street to vary the rear setbacks of strata lots 11, 15, 39, 40, 41 and 47, and the front setback for strata lot 40.
- Council recommended the application to the Liquor and Cannabis Regulation Branch for a <u>new outdoor patio area</u> at the Royal Canadian Legion Branch No.99 be approved.
- The Mayor and Corporate Officer were authorized to enter into an <u>Election Cost-Sharing</u> <u>Agreement</u> with School District No. 83.
- Propane charges to the Sicamous Curling Club for the <u>2020/21 season</u> will be reduced by 50 per cent following approval from Council. Council has directed the Community Services Manager to negotiate a new lease agreement with the Club prior to the 2022/23 season.
- The new <u>Animal Control Bylaw No. 1013, 2022</u>, which regulates responsible pet ownership within the District, was adopted by Council.
- Council adopted the <u>2022-2026 Financial Plan Bylaw No. 1018, 2022</u> which is includes projected operating and capital expenditures over five years. This is a legislative requirement for local governments under the *Community Charter*.
- <u>Fees and Charges Amending Bylaw No. 1016, 2022</u>, which was given Third Reading on March 9, 2022, was rescinded and the amended version was given Second and Third Reading.
- The <u>Election & Assent Voting Amending Bylaw No. 1017, 2022</u> was given First, Second and Third Reading. If adopted, it will allow for Mail Ballot Voting in the 2022 General Local Election.
- The <u>Tax Rates Bylaw No. 1022, 2022</u>, which sets 2022 municipal tax rates, was given First, Second and Third Reading.
- Council directed Staff to conduct a site visit with BC Timber Sales regarding planned <u>logging</u> activity in the <u>Sicamous and Wiseman Creek Watershed areas</u>. BCTS will be welcomed to present as a delegation at a future meeting.
- Council agreed to donate \$500 to <u>Sicamous Minor Softball</u> in support of the Sicamous Ladies Fastball Tournament being held at Finlayson Park June 4-5, 2022 and to provide the 'Eagles Nest" at no cost to house umpires over the weekend.
