MARCH 24, 2021 COUNCIL MEETING

- Council passed Resolution #21-136 to support an art installation at the Sicamous Beach Park should the community be chosen as a location for SASCU's 75th Anniversary Legacy Project. SASCU is commissioning an artist or group of artists to design, fabricate and install an artwork within its geographical business area. Artists will be called to submit an Expression of Interest (EOI) for the project that has an total budget of \$65K.
- Council gave First, Second and Third Reading to "2021-2025 Financial Plan Bylaw No. 988, 2021" and the "Ticket Information Utilization Amending Bylaw No. 983, 2021". Bylaw No. 983 includes increased traffic regulation fines comparable to neighbouring municipalities and is expected to encourage greater compliance. Both bylaws will be considered for adoption at the April 14, 2021 Regular Council Meeting.
- Council passed Resolution #21-142 to authorize the expense of one, \$1,000 scholarship and two, \$500 scholarships for Eagle River Secondary School graduates. Considered recipients will be residents of Sicamous who intend to continue their education at a post-secondary institution within two years of graduation.
- Council passed Resolution #21-145 to submit a letter to the Minister of Transportation and Infrastructure endorsing the "[Let's Ride Campaign](#)" which calls for a provincewide, public-transit network. The campaign is a response to the lack of bus service in rural in remote communities since Greyhound's exit from B.C. in 2018.
- Council passed Resolution #21-146 to write a letter to North-Okanagan Shuswap MP, Mel Arnold, in support of the Canadian Boat Rental Safety Coalition who is advocating the Minister of Transport regarding the possible removal of the Rental Boat Safety Checklist as proof of competency in Canada.
