## COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS



## APRIL 14, 2021 COUNCIL MEETING

• The Mayor established the Planning & Development Committee, which will act in an advisory capacity to Council regarding the implementation of the <u>Official Community Plan</u>. The Committee will be comprised of two Council members and two community members who will be appointed by the Mayor.

• Council has entered into an Advertising Space Agreement with What the Woof Pet Supplies for advertising space on dog bag dispensers throughout the District for an annual fee of \$200 plus installation costs. Council directed Staff to prepare options for a partnering agreement with Glenn's Water Taxi that would allow the business to utilize the public wharves in exchange for towing and enforcement services of vessels illegally moored on public docks overnight.

• Council adopted the Ticket Information Utilization Amendment Bylaw No. 983, 2021 which increases fines for traffic infractions to encourage compliance.

• Council adopted two amending bylaws to allow the development of a storage facility at 1713 Hillier Road. Bylaw No. 994, 2021 amends the OCP designation from Residential Medium Density to General Industrial and Bylaw No. 995, 2021 amends the zoning from R1A Urban Single Family Residential to I-1A Light Industrial.

 Council gave first, second and third reading to the Neighbourhood Zero Emission Bylaw No. 999, 2021 which will allow the vehicles to operate on roadways with a speed limit of 50/KM hour or less. The Bylaw will be considered for adoption at the April 28, 2021 Council Meeting.

• Council will attend the <u>SILGA</u> Virtual AGM on April 28, 2021 and is optimistic that resolutions regarding classifying Asian Clams as invasive species and increased enforcement for watercraft owners who fail to clean, drain and dry their watercraft will be recommended to <u>UBCM</u>.
