BYLAWS

- · Council adopted the Tax Rate Bylaw No. 1001, 2021.
- Council gave first, second and third reading of the **Good Neighbour Bylaw No. 1005**.
- Council gave first and second reading to the following bylaws: **Zoning Amendment Bylaw No. 1004**, **2021 and Zoning Amendment Bylaw No. 1006**. Public Hearings will be scheduled for both bylaws, allowing for public comment.

PLANNING & DEVELOPMENT

The following applications were approved by Council:

- Council supported the relocation of the Liquor Primary Licence held by Marina Bay Steak House and Bar, formerly located at 102 Martin Street to 200 Old Town Road at the Old Town Bay Marina Pub.
- Development Variance Permit No. 20-317-DVP for 62 Montcalm Crescent varying Zoning Bylaw No. 101, 1993, Section 311(1)(f) permitting the construction of a retaining wall within 15 metres of the natural boundary of Mara Lake.
- Development Variance Permit No. 21-122-DVP for 1201 Shuswap Ave, Varying Zoning Bylaw No. 101, 1993, Section 401(2)(c)(iv) to allow a setback of 1.74 metres for commercial buildings and structures exterior.
- Development Permit No. 21-130-DVP for 1016 Hemlock Cres N, varying Zoning Bylaw No. 101, 1993, Section 601 (2)(b)(ii) to increase the maximim height of residential accessory building to eight metres and Section 601()(b) to increase the maximum lot coverage to 45.5 per cent.
