

COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS | MAY 11, 2022



- British Columbia Timber Sales (BCTS) presented on their proposed Sicamous Wiseman Creek Fire Salvage presentation.
- Council approved the temporary closure of Main Street, from Shuswap Ave to the Narrows Smokehouse, on Friday May 27, 2022 from 6 8 pm for a <u>Sicamous Chamber of Commerce Biz to Biz</u> event.
- Council authorized the purchase of a new <u>2023 Fire Engine</u> from Fort Garry Fire Trucks for a total cost of \$716,877.53 (including taxes), funded from the Fire Equipment Reserve.
- Council awarded the purchase of a <u>2011 Dodge Ram 5500 Crane Truck</u> to Electric Motor and Pump Service Ltd. for the purchase price of \$68,000 + GST.
- Council approved <u>Development Permit 21-159-DP</u> for a new Visitor Accommodation and Multi-Family Dwelling at 806 Trans Canada Highway.
- Council gave First and Second Reading to <u>Zoning Bylaw Amendment No. 22-043-Z</u> to reduce the rear setbacks in the R1A—Urban Single Family Residential zone.
- Council gave First and Second Reading to <u>Zoning Bylaw Amendment No. 22-063-Z</u> to allow secondary suites within a Two-Family Dwelling located at 506/508 Kappel Street.
- Council gave Second Reading to the District of <u>Sicamous Zoning Bylaw No. 1000, 2022</u>, which is proposed to replace the current *District of Sicamous Zoning Bylaw No. 101, 1993*.
- The <u>Fees & Charges Amending Bylaw No. 1016, 2022</u>, which updated fees for the rental of the Sicamous stage and wash car, was adopted.
- The <u>Election & Asset Voting Amending Bylaw No. 1017, 2022</u>, which introduces the option of mail -in ballot voting, was adopted by Council.
- <u>Tax Rates Bylaw No. 1022, 2022</u>, which sets the rates for the 2022 Property Taxes, was adopted by Council.
- Council gave First, Second and Third Reading to the <u>Council Procedure Amendment Bylaw No.</u>
 1015, 2022 which allows electronic participation from Council.
- Council gave First, Second and Third Reading to the <u>Good Neighbour Amending Bylaw No. 1019</u>, 2022, which addresses general nuisances, such as light and odors.
