

FACILITY RENTALS FAQ:

Q - What parks or facilities are available to rent?

Finlayson Park, Sicamous Beach Park, Lions Park, Sicamous Dog Park, Wash Car, Stage, Curling Rink, the Eagles Nest.

Q- Is there a fee to rent District-owned facilities?

Yes. There is a \$200 refundable damage deposit. Rental of the District stage, portable wash car and facilities such as the Curling Rink and the Eagles Nest have rental rates and damage deposits.

Q - When you book park space for an event, do you have sole access during that time?

No. As a public park, the public cannot be restricted access. However, the District can secure a designated area for your event. Please note the Sicamous Beach Park can not be blocked off to the public.

Q - If I want to rent the District Stage or Wash Car do I have to set it up?

No. The rental fee includes setup of these items. Please note that the wash car requires special transportation and additional fees apply.
