

COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS | JULY 13, 2022



- Council approved a [Temporary Community Showcase](#) at 425 Main Street that will allow the District of Sicamous Development Corporation, the Sicamous and District Chamber of Commerce and Visitor Information Centre to promote Sicamous events and businesses this summer.
- Council directed staff to prepare a report for the July 27, 2022 Regular Council Meeting to consider [designated temporary use permit areas](#) within the District's *Official Community Plan Bylaw No. 918, 2016*.
- Council heard delegations from Deb Heap regarding Communities in Bloom, Greg Darroch regarding Development Variance Permit 22-143-DVP, and Steve Seelinger regarding 200 Main Street.
- Council approved to [temporarily suspend enforcement](#) of *Zoning Bylaw No. 101, 1993* from July 21–24, 2022 in support of the 2022 Monashee Music Festival.
- Council approved [Development Variance Permit 22-159-DVP](#) to vary the front setback of 206 Martin Street from 6.0m to 4.79m.
- Council approved [Development Permit 22-201-DP and Development Variance Permit 22-201-DVP](#) for 1118 Riverside Ave to increase the number of marina berths from 52 to 54.
- Council approved the cancellation of the August 10, 2022 Regular Council meeting.
- Council adopted [District Asset Naming Policy No. PW-18](#), replacing Street Naming Policy PW-18, to govern the naming and/or renaming of District assets in recognition of individuals and organizations who have made significant contributions to Sicamous.
- Council gave First, Second and Third Reading to [District of Sicamous Water Regulations, Rental & Connection Charge Amending Bylaw No. 1023, 2022](#), which proposes water restriction stages within the municipality.
