

 - Active use setting (playspace, games/courts)
 - Gathering/Community space (picnic tables/hosting)
- 3. Host open house to seek Community engagement.






Mixed Use Health and Healing Areas

Interior Building Usage Allocation (Approx. 15,000 sq. ft.)


