## Outcomes

- \* There is a need for coordination, resources and leadership:
  - To provide a centralized information hub to connect landlords and tenants
  - To provide and manage housing of alternative tenure types (rental, Co-Op, rent-to-own, AIP)
  - To promote existing opportunities and incentives to homeowners
- \* There is a desire for clear language around the needs of seniors.
- \* There is strong support for infill housing in our low density neighbourhoods
- \* There is confirmation that mixed use and high density residential development is considered to be compatible with all our commercial areas, not just the Town Centre.
- \* There is a need to protect existing housing stock from re-development and the loss of family housing to the growth of the short-term rental industry.
